FINAL RESULTS ON THE PLEBISCITE HELD ON TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 5, 2024

In accordance with Act No. 165 of 2020, known as the "Act to Implement the Statehood Petition of the 2020 Plebiscite", the Puerto Rico State Elections Commission reports that the results of the 2024 Plebiscite consultation held on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, with 100% of the polling stations reported for the election canvass, are those that are accompanied and incorporated as an integral part of this certification.

These final and official results certified by the State Election Commission of Puerto Rico constitute the legitimate expression of a majority of voters and the exercise of the right to self-determination of the U.S. citizens of Puerto Rico to finally solve their current political status. Furthermore, it constitutes the claim of a majority of voters protected by the First Amendment to the U.S. Constitution to petition the Congress and the President for a redress of grievances arising out of the current territorial status established 127 years ago.

Any other interpretation of these results shall be contrary to the rights of a majority of U.S. citizens of Puerto Rico who cast their vote willingly, validly, and democratically, in accordance with federal law, the laws, and the case law of the Supreme Court of Puerto Rico.
